LOTTERY AWARD

It was announced at 1999 AGM, that the Archive had made a successful bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund, Small Grants Celebrating the Millennium, and received just under £5,000. It enabled us to take on a worker to develop aspects of the work of the Archive. We count ourselves

extremely lucky that the post was accepted by Sue Gwyther, who began work in February this year, and worked for approximately three months. Sue's own report on her work is currently being prepared for printing, and will be available to members soon.

The steering committee wants to use this opportunity to thank Sue for the enthusiastic and effective way she took on the work. For us, the most important outcome has been that the Archive is now firmly established as collections of material deposited in record offices. Sue put in place systems for the transfer of pre-donated materials, and generated new donations through a great deal of effective publicity in print and broadcast media, and through personal contact with groups and individuals. A list of the deposited collections follows this item.

Sue also organised the re-launch of the Archive, and an exhibition from our collection of Menna Gallie papers, at the very successful and enjoyable Mamwlad 2000/Motherland 2000 conference at Trinity College Carmarthen in April, organised by Dr. Katie Gramich (see Report later).

The overall result has been increased membership, support from women's and community groups, many of who intend to deposit their records with the Archive, and greatly increased awareness of our activities throughout Wales.

We thank the Heritage Lottery Fund for the grant which made this possible. We plan to re-apply this year.

MOTHERLAND 2000 CONFERENCE

Driving to Carmarthen in the clear green light of an April evening was an auspicious start to a memorable weekend. Motherland 2000, the conference on Welsh Women's History and Writing (7 to 9 April), proved to be an outstanding success in many ways.

The programme included papers by distinguished feminist historians and writers, each of which was both thought-provoking and accessible to the varied interests of the 100 or so people gathered in the Halliwell Centre of Trinity College, and which, together, formed an overview of Welsh women's lives and achievements at

the turn of the Millennium.

But Motherland 2000 was much more than a collection of academic papers and literary readings. There was plenty to browse through in the breaks between papers. An exhibition of the bardic crowns and medals won by women in the National Eisteddfod over the years, was appropriately inspirational as well as displaying beautiful objects. A selection of photos and documents from the Menna Gallie archive, which had recently been given to AMC/WAW, was augmented by the loan of two portraits of Menna, giving an insight into the life of this important Welsh writer.

Furthermore, the Women's Archive of Wales used the occasion of the conference to launch our new portable display panels, designed to publicise the work and objectives of the Archive. Also in the conference room was a most tempting bookstall provided by Honno, which did much to lighten our purses before the end of the weekend.

Turning to domestic matters, the accommodation, catering and friendly bar provided by Trinity College were excellent and created a warm and relaxed atmosphere, conducive to long and wide-ranging discussions over coffee in the dining room and drinks in the bar, to the deepening of old

friendships and the developing of new ones. The fact that the conference lasted from Friday evening to Sunday afternoon allowed the dynamics of the event to develop in a very satisfactory way.

But it was the combination of all these elements which made Motherland 2000 such a special and celebratory event, and one which I, for one, very much hope will be repeated. Many people were involved in organising Motherland 2000, too many to list, but they all deserve a big 'Thank you'!
